MID CONFERENCE EVENTS

After the field day, on the third day of the Conference, two different tours will be offered (from 4 pm to 7-8pm) to be booked during the first day of the conference. Some cultural events will be organized during the nights to allow the delegates to know more about Mozambican culture. An end of the day trip is also available in which you will be fetched from your hotel and taken to a seafood restaurant. After dinner local music is on the menu visiting at least 2 pubs. Depending on the day your evening can end at a nightclub where you may dance. More information about those events and tours will be provided during the Conference.

PRE AND POST CONFERENCE TOURS AND EXCURSIONS With its Mediterranean style architecture, flame-tree-lined avenues, sidewalk cafés and waterside setting, Maputo is a very attractive city. Just across the bay is Inhaca Island, an attractive holiday destination, with breathtaking beaches, coral reefs and exotic marine life. Macaneta is the closest beach and can be part of your Mozambique visit. You can also visit the

Maputo Special Reserve where you can see elephants, crocodiles, hippos and other small sized animals. Short tours to visit the city as well as day trips or excursions to the mentioned places are available at your own cost. Because Kruger Park, in South Africa, is nearby if you are interested a full day trip or excursion that can be arranged.

1. PRE AND/OR POST CONFERENCE TOURS AND EXCURSIONS

City Tour of Maputo: morning and afternoon day tours (3 hours). Stops include the Fortress, Central Market, Museum of Natural History, and Railway Station. Cost pp: US\$80 for 1 PAX, US\$40 for 2PAX, US\$35 for 3 PAX and US\$30 for 4+ PAX

Mafalala Walking Tour: an eye opening adventure! Mafalala is one of the cultural and political cradles of Mozambique. This tour explains local ethno-cultural differences, tells of the famous political leaders, writers, musicians and sporting heroes, as well as giving a historical

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perspective of the last 50 years. While you walk around the streets, alleys and market, you learn about local foods and medicines, enjoy traditional dance of the Macua people and interact with local school children. Duration: 2 hours. Cost pp: US\$110 for 1 PAX, US\$55 for 2PAX, US\$37 for 3 PAX, US\$25 for 4-5 PAX or US\$ 21 for 6+ PAX.

Baixa (Downtown) Walking tour: walk along Rua Bagamoyo and discover the origins of the city. Hear about the efforts of the British, Danish and Portuguese to colonize Mozambique and the importance of the South African gold transported through the magnificent railway station. Learn about the area's social history and the bar life recorded by Rangel. See the extent of the 19th Century city from the fort wall and hear about hardships for the early settlers. Duration: 2 hours. Cost pp: US\$70 for 1 PAX, US\$35 for 2PAX, US\$30 for 3 PAX, US\$25 4+ PAX

Pancho Guedes Walking Tour: See the amazing playful buildings constructed in the city between 1950 and the mid 70's. Our expert architect will explain how Gaudi and Frank Lloyd Wright influenced Guedes. Visit where Pancho lived, worked and encouraged different Mozambican artists. You will see also some of Pancho unique murals and organic buildings.

Duration: half day. Cost pp: US\$70 for 1 PAX, US\$35 for 2PAX, US\$30 for 3 PAX, US\$25 for 4+ PAX

Maputo Special Reserve Day Trip: depart from your hotel at dawn taking a packed breakfast with you. Cross by the ferry to Catembe and continue via Hindu temple at Salamanga to the Maputo Elephant reserve. There is prolific birdlife and hopefully you will see elephants, crocodiles, hippos, monkeys en route to Ponta Milibangalala. Lunch will be served in the beach and, time and weather permitting, there might be a chance for a swim at the coast. Cost pp (includes lunch, drinks and snacks and park entrée fee): US\$550 for 1 PAX, US\$295 for 2PAX, US\$220 for 3 PAX, US\$175 for 4+ PAX

Macaneta Day Trip: Macaneta is located 40 Km north of Maputo. The journey is a 4 x 4 and you either cross the Incomati river by local ferry or in a boat cruise up the river. After arriving you have the morning to swim in the warm Indian Ocean. A seafood lunch is served at a local restaurant. Duration: full day (departure from Hotel:8:00 am). Cost pp: US\$330 for 1 PAX, US\$180 for 2PAX, US\$130 for 3 PAX, US\$105 for 4+ PAX crossing the river on local ferry or US\$425 for 1 PAX, US\$255 for 2PAX, US\$175 for 3 PAX or US\$125 for 4+ PAX (with boat trip)

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Inhaca Day trip: Inhaca and Portuguese islands are located across Maputo bay. Boats take 1 to 2 hours to reach the islands (please check with us the departure time). Most boats stop first at Portuguese island where you may spend the morning swimming and then transfer to Inhaca (15 minutes) where a lunch can be pre-booked. Please ask for information about overnight stays at Pestana Inhaca Lodge. Cost pp (includes transfers and lunch): US\$110 for 1 PAX, US\$55 for 2PAX, US\$37 for 3 PAX, US\$25 for 4-5 PAX or US\$ 21 for 6+ PAX.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Excursions and trips should be booked in advance and are subjected to availability. Excursions and trips are dependent on the weather and may be cancelled but people will be informed with much notice possible and re-booked where feasible. The timing of departure should be confirmed the day prior to the excursion/trip take place. A voucher will be provided once payment has been received. Please make certain you take your passport (or a valid copy in case you do not cross the border) with you.
